In exchange for the enclosed membership fee for The New Park 'N Play, the below signed agree to abide by the rules and regulations listed below. I understand that enrollment is limited and payment does not automatically entitle me to membership. If enrollment has been met and membership is not available, any fees paid to PNP will be returned to me.

I acknowledge that The New Park 'N Play is not responsible for supervising me or my children and the use of the facility is at my own risk. The New PNP shall not be liable for injury or damage to myself or my child/children or anyone else named as caregiver, arising out of or in connection with my use of The New PNP. I also agree to indemnify and hold harmless the New PNP, its officers, directors, employees and affiliated entities from all claims and damages of any kind. Including but not limited to, reasonable attorney fees arising out of connection with the use of The New PNP.

This agreement entitles the above to six months unlimited use of The New PNP, 9:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., Monday-Thursday, November-April. The New PNP reserves the right to close due to certain weather conditions. The hours are subject to change in conjunction with the First Presbyterian Church's schedule. There will be no refunds but this membership is transferable.

It is important that all members cooperate in order to make The New PNP a safe place to play. By signing the following, the prospective member or guest acknowledges that they understand and agree to all of the terms and rules listed herein.

| 1. Only children 6 years old or under who have not finished Kindergarten can be members or guests. | 8. Keep the play area and bathroom clean. Diapers are to be changed in designated areas, not in bathroom. |
| 2. Children must be under the supervision of a parent/guardian at all times. You are responsible for the behavior of your children, not the supervisor of PNP. | 9. Do not let children climb on the stage, tables or stand on the chairs. |
| 3. Parents/Guardians are responsible for putting away toys after their child's use. | 10. Do not bring toys from home. A toy that is safe for a 4 year old can cause a 1 year old to choke. |
| 4. Children who are ill with contagious diseases or fever may not use the center. A child must be symptom-free for 24 hours before using the PNP. | 11. Folding chairs are not permitted in play area as they pose a safety hazard to small children. |
| 5. Verbal or physical abuse of any kind will not be permitted. | 12. Fees are non-refundable. |
| 6. Rough play or running is not permitted. | 13. Adults and children must take off their shoes. |
| 7. No smoking and no food are allowed. Feeding of infants is permitted only in designated areas. | 14. Members are allowed to bring in up to 5 guests per season at the cost of \$10.00 per visiting family. |
| | 15. Members, guests & visitors must follow all parking rules for the safety of the children of PNP. |

Any violation of these rules will result in a warning for the first incident, after the second incident the child or caregiver will be asked to leave that day: any further incidents are grounds for revocation of membership at the discretion of the Executive Board.
